Please join our recycling initiative by getting your friends and family involved!

PAPER: Newspapers (including all inserts), magazines, phone books, catalogs, books (including paperbacks, textbooks and hardbacks), writing and computer paper, mail, paperboard (e.g., cereal, frozen food, and shoe boxes), cardboard (flattened), milk and juice cartons/boxes, cardstock, copy

paper (including NCR - No Carbon Required - copy paper), envelopes (plastic windows ok), fax paper, ice cream containers, letterhead paper, non-metallic wrapping paper, paper bags

METAL: Aluminum and steel food and beverage cans, EMPTY aerosol cans, aluminum foil and pie pans

GLASS: All colors of glass bottles and jars

PLASTIC: Narrow-neck plastic bottles and jugs (with a 1 to 7 recycling symbol), wide-mouth plastic containers (such as butter, cottage cheese, peanut butter, yogurt, mayonnaise, sour cream, and whipped topping containers), rigid plastics (such as buckets [with or without metal handles], drinking cups, flower pots, coolers, drums, 5-gallon water bottles, lawn furniture, pallets, plastic window well covers, clothes hangers, and toys)

POOLS OPEN MEMORIAL DAY WEEKEND!

Corvias Military Living will open the Neighborhood Center pools at Potomac Place, Meuse Forest, Heritage Park, and Midway Common to all on-post residents beginning on Saturday, May 25 at 11:00 a.m. for Memorial Day weekend. Please see below for the hours of operation for the summer:

May 28 - June 8:
Saturday, Sunday and Holidays: 11:00 a.m. - 8:00 p.m.

Monday - Friday: 4:00 - 8:00 p.m.
June 9 - August 21:
Sunday - Thursday: 11:00 a.m. - 7:00 p.m.
Friday - Saturday: 11:00 a.m. - 8:00 p.m.

August 27 - September 3:
Saturday, Sunday and Holidays: 11:00 a.m. - 8:00 p.m.

Monday - Friday: 4:00 - 8:00 p.m.

*Please note Midway's pool opens at 11:30 a.m. Monday-Friday.

The pool is available for use to residents living on post. Residents will need to provide pool passes and an id to access the pool. Four guests are allowed per family. Residents who have a pool pass from the 2012 season may use it in 2013. Residents who do not have a pool pass should pick one up at their Neighborhood Office.

Each pool can accommodate a certain amount of people on a first come, first serve basis. At maximum capacity the management and lifeguards on duty may ask residents to come back later or try another pool.
